

**REGULATIONS
Of
THE OLD JAIL & PARK AREA
Of
THE CANTON FLEA MARKET**

1. Upon arrival you must register in the office and pick up your City Permit and State Sales Tax Forms. The State Tax Commission requires all exhibitors to collect the 7% Sales Tax and to remit it to their sponsor, who in turns remits to City of Canton. A tax form is included in your permit package. This form, along with the remittance, must be turned in to the Office after 4 PM and prior to leaving for the day. **IF YOUR TAX IS NOT PAID THE DAY OF THE FLEA MARKET YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN A PERMIT FOR FUTURE MARKETS.**
2. Arts, crafts, antiques, live plants, collectibles, clothes, and accessories may be displayed and sold. Items do not have to be handmade.
3. **Canopies, merchandise and setups for booths must be erected within the exhibitor's space.**
4. There are a very few spaces with electrical outlets. Please advise if you need electricity. No generators will be allowed.
5. **No pets will be allowed in the exhibitors spaces.**
6. The Historical Society is not responsible for security of the exhibits.
7. Exhibitors may begin setting up at noon on Tuesday if grounds are ready. Check with the officer before setting up. You must maintain your booth until the closing hour of **5 PM on Thursday afternoon.**
8. **Refunds can be given with one (1) month's notice of cancellation and if we are able to fill the vacancy.**
9. **INVITATION MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER NAME.** You may not let someone else use your booth. You must notify the Old Jail Flea Market Manager if you cannot attend. **IF A SPACE IS OPERATED BY SOMEONE ELSE, WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION, YOU WILL NOT BE INVITED BACK.**
10. Each exhibitor shall maintain and leave their space in a neat and clean manner.
11. **AN EXHIBITOR MAY SETUP IN ONLY ONE LOCATION IN CANTON.**
